## **LIBRARY Hours**

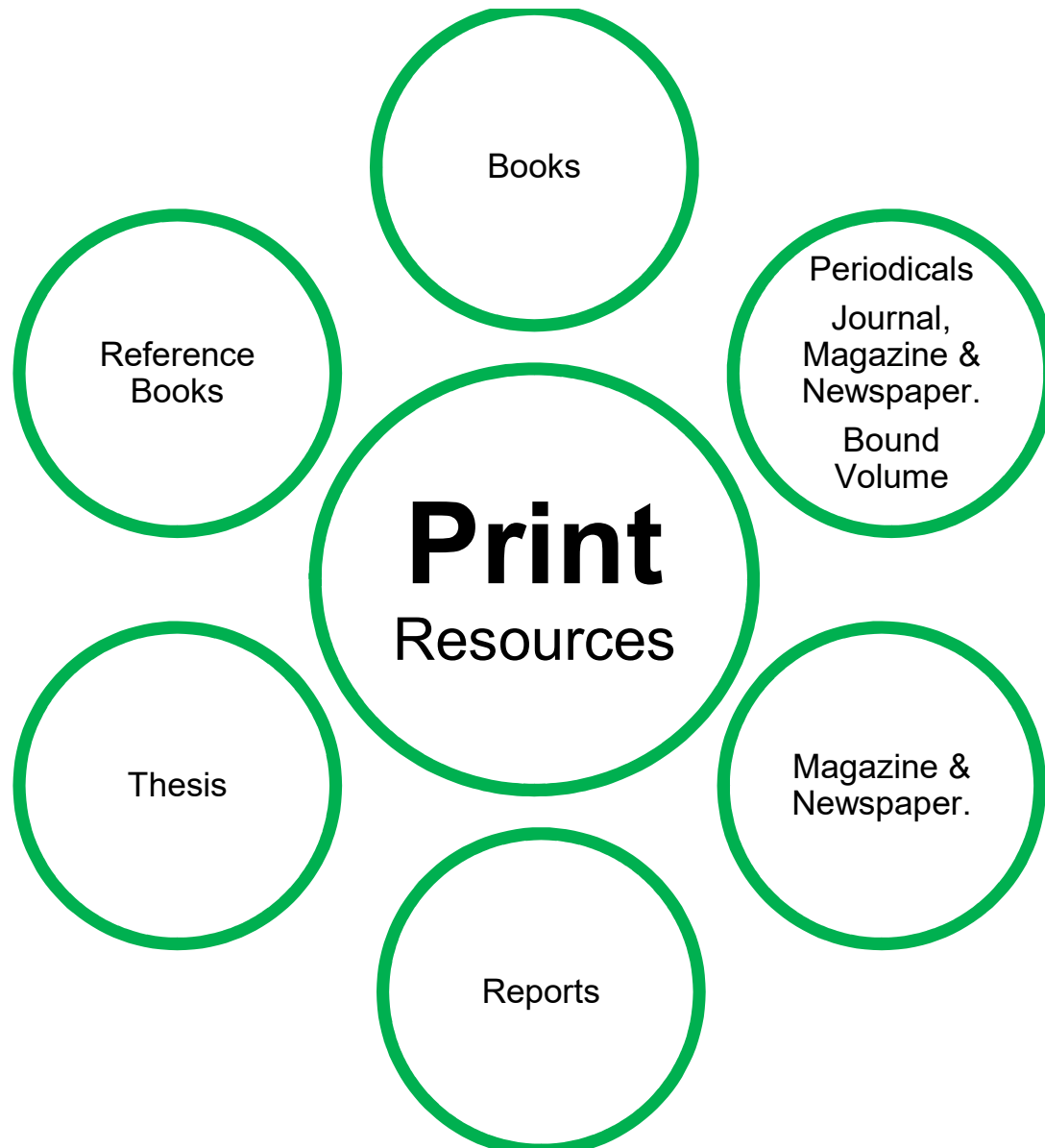


**Library opens at 9:30 a.m. and closes at 6:00 p.m.**

- **Library Circulation Section remains closed only on holidays declared by the University.**

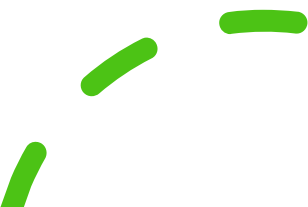

## Circulation Policy

Category	No of Books	Loan Period	Fine per day(Each item)
<b>Student</b>	<b>6</b>	<b>15 Days</b>	<b>Rs. 1/-</b>

- Identity Card is compulsory for getting access to the library and to borrow books.
- Identity Card is not transferable. The student is responsible for the book borrowed on his/her card.
- The student has to check the condition of books while borrowing.
- In case any book is lost or damaged by the Student, they shall replace the book or to pay the double cost of the book..
- Absence from the college will not be allowed as an excuse for the delay in the return of books.

# LIBRARY RULES & REGULATIONS

- Student must enter in the “*Library Visitor register/IN OUT system*” before enter in the Library
- Keep your bag and personal books out of the library, when enter into the library.
- Use of Mobile Phone in the Library is strictly prohibited

# LIBRARY RULES & REGULATIONS

- Talking loudly are strictly prohibited in the Library.
- News paper and Magazine must be read only in the Library and should not be taken outside.
- Reference book and Magazine will be not issued. Use only in the Library
- Any mischief of library book like marking inside/tear of the pages will be treated seriously and double cost will be charged

# HOW TO MAKE OUR READING ROOM EXPERIENCE

- HAVE TO maintain cleanliness.
- Use the dustbin.
- HAVE TO put the mobile on silent mode.
- SHOULD NOT chew; take food or beverages inside.
- SHOULD NOT speak on mobile– should not talk loud.
- SHOULD NOT disturb other readers
- SHOULD NOT fold/tear the book's pages or mark it with pen/pencil.
